The team from California had a wonderful time traveling into the mountains daily and to see the children's expressions as we arrived was very special. The missionary (Nelson Vesise) and his wife were also blessed to see the work of our Lord. We left them very encouraged.

My wife, Mary, was able to be on this trip and this was also something special for me. One experience I will never forget was on the last day as we were shopping. We entered a very large and old Catholic Cathedral (built in the 1400"s). It was truly remarkable to see this incredible building. As we entered, we could see very elaborate wall paintings, candles burning everywhere, and people praying over dead saints that where in glass boxes in plain view. People were praying to the saints and burning candles, reciting prayers with the hope of getting people out of purgatory and into Heaven. In many ways, it was a very spiritual dark place.

I noticed about 25 Spanish teens walking around looking at all that was happening in this building and I was moved by the Spirit (The HOLY SPIRIT) to gather them together and share the truth with them. I passed out the salvation bracelets to them and their teacher and began sharing the Gospel. After about 15-20 minutes, each of the teens and their teacher got down on their knees and prayed the sinners prayer. It was an unbelievable thing to be apart of. To see our Lord Jesus work in this place, to see Him shine His light in a place so dark, and to witness His Spirit draw people even when Satan himself was deceiving so many right around us. I wanted to preach so badly, to tell everyone there that JESUS is LORD and there is no other way but through Him.

The missionary (Nelson) was very nervous. He was concerned that a priest was going to come in and stop us but our Lord had great plans for those teens. It was their day to be saved even in Satan's camp. Our God is so GOOD! As you can tell, I'm still very excited about being a part of such a great work.
