Hello everyone, it has been a great summer. The Lord has blessed as we have taken trips last month to both Honduras and Guatemala.

The first trip to Honduras was with a team consisting of several team members from south Alabama and the Dallas, Texas area. We traveled each day through the mountains to remote Lenca Indiana Villages. The people were very receptive to the team and to the Gospel. There were over 900 Adults and children that prayed to give their lives to Jesus. Honduras is a great location to do Happy Feet simply because the Indians are very humble. The team stayed in a seminary that is located at the foot hills of the mountains. This made the daily travel to the villages easy. On a couple of days, we stopped on the roadside to talk with the locals that were working in the fields. The Lenca's are a hardworking people. They understand, for the most part, that if they don't work, they will not eat. They truly do live off of the land. The times we stopped to talk with them they were a little guarded, but after a few minutes, they seemed to be very friendly. We passed out salvation bracelets and begin to share the Gospel with a few large groups. It was remarkable to see these people on their knees in a dirt field holding their tools in one hand and looking at their bracelet in the other hand. It was exciting to witness these people get into a big circle, hold hands with their heads down and praying together confessing their sins and asking the Lord to save them.

I also had the opportunity to be in a Catholic Church in one of the villages. They had a planned village meeting that day. The Indians had come from all of the local villages. We asked if we could talk with them after they were through with their meeting. They invited us in, and I and the missionary stood on the stage after passing out over 500 salvation bracelets. After explaining the bracelet, all that were there in this old Catholic Church stood to their feet in response to the invitation. It's amazing to hear that many people pray out loud to give their lives to Christ. It truly was as tremendous week.

On the second trip, the team from California spent their week in the Mayan villages in the mountains of Guatemala. And again, the Lord blessed as we traveled each day into the villages and washed feet and shared the Good News.

At this time, we are staying busy with fundraising and planning for the October Extreme Trip. We will be traveling to the Amazon Basin to work with the local Indians. We will be traveling up the Amazon each day to small villages that are along the banks of the river. I know the guys are getting ready to go, so please pray as we prepare ourselves for that week in October.

Also, please pray for our safety and that many will come to Christ. Also, please be in prayer for the finances of Happy Feet. We are not unlike any other ministry in that we depend on contributions and fundraising to support Happy Feet.
